

ORDINANCE NO. 149565

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to sign a Purchase Order as a contract with Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc., for communications equipment associated with the Emergency Medical Services project for the Bureau of Electronic Services, at the estimated amount of \$40,000, without advertising for bids, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Electronic Services requires communications equipment to be utilized for the establishment of an Emergency Medical Services system;
2. Participating organizations and other government agencies have purchased this unique equipment and no other product is compatible with their system, and it is therefore impractical to obtain competition;
3. It is in the public interest for Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc., to provide the communications equipment at an estimated cost of \$40,000, without advertising for bids;
4. This purchase has been reviewed and approved by the Purchasing Agent.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall sign a Purchase Order to serve as a contract with Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc., for the items mentioned in Section 1 for the total estimated amount of approximately \$40,000, without advertising for bids. The P.O. shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1979-80 Bureau of Electronic Services Budget (36000201.644) when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

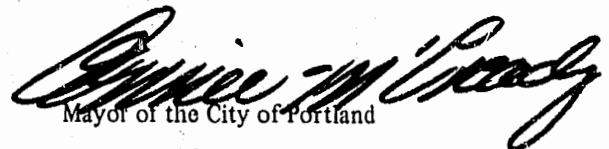
ORDINANCE No.
