

ORDINANCE NO. 149583

An Ordinance amending Section 3.98.010 of Chapter 3.98, Towing Board of Review, of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon, by redefining the voting members of the Towing Board of Review, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Ordinance No. 148973 passed by the Council December 27, 1979, approved consolidation of the Bureau of Neighborhood Environment into the Bureau of Buildings.
2. The Bureau of Buildings and the Bureau of Neighborhood Environment each had a voting representative on the Towing Board of Review prior to the consolidation.
3. That the Towing Board of Review should reflect, through its membership, the merger of these two bureaus.

NOT, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That Chapter 3.98, Section 3.98.010 of the Code of the City of Portland is hereby ammended to read as follows:


There hereby is created a Towing Board of Review, hereinafter referred to as the Board, consisting of seven voting members and two nonvoting members. The voting members of the Board shall be: Two representatives as designated by the Director of the Bureau of Buildings; the Chief of Police or his designate; the Traffic Engineer or his designate; and three members of the general public with no ties to the towing industry appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Council to serve for a period of two years. The Mayor shall designate one of the seven voting members to serve as chairman, who shall so serve during his pleasure. The two nonvoting members shall be representatives of the towing industry appointed by the Mayor to serve for a one year period subject to confirmation by the Council. All members of the Board are to serve without pay, except that they may receive their regular salary during the time spent on matters of the Board. A vacancy on the Board shall be filled in accordance with the appointment procedure described heretofore. A quorum shall consist of four members.


