## ORDINANCE No. 190287

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant Headworks Screening Improvements Project No. E10805 for an estimated amount of \$12 million (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
  - The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) operates the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant (CBWTP) to provide wastewater treatment for the City of Portland, in accordance with State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) issued NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit requirements.
  - 2. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to construct improvements to the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant (CBWTP) Headworks.
  - 3. The estimated cost is \$12,000,000. The level of confidence in the estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 21-22, FY 22-23, and FY 23-24 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10805.
  - 4. BES seeks Council's authorization for Procurement Services to issue a competitive solicitation and execute a contract for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with City Code Chapter 5.34 in order to obtain the most responsible and responsive bid for the construction of the CBWTP Headworks Screening Improvements Project.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office, with the lowest responsive bidder for the purposes described in Section 1.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
