ORDINANCE NO. 149589

An Ordinance making it unlawful for any person to possess any alcoholic liquor in, or to take any alcoholic liquor into or upon that area generally described as Waterfront Park, as more particularly described herein for the period from June 6 through June 15, 1980, both dates inclusive, notwithstanding Section 20.12.040 of the City Code, providing for penalties, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- (1) The City has issued to the Rose Festival Association a revocable permit to use portions of the City-State owned property east of and adjacent to the east curbline of Front Avenue which area has been designated a public park to hold their annual carnival and exhibitition for the period from June 6 through June 15, 1980, both dates inclusive.
- (2) It is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare that it be made unlawful for any person to possess any alcoholic liquor in, or take any alcoholic liquor into or upon such area as herein described during the period from June 6 through June 15, 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

(a) It is unlawful for any person to possess any alcoholic liquor in, or take any alcoholic liquor into or or upon that area generally known as Waterfront Park as hereinafter described during the period from June 6, 1980 through June 15, 1980, both dates inclusive, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 20.12.040 of the Code of the City of Portland. This ordinance applies to the property described as:

> The area whose boundaries generally are described as the Willamette River Seawall, the north curbline of S.W. Jefferson Street extended, the east curbline of Front Avenue, and south curbline of N.W. Glisan Street extended, in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon.

(b) Violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be a violation of the Code of the City of Portland, subject to the penalties provided for by Section 14.08.020 of the City Code.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares:

In order that provision may be made to allow the City to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the users of Waterfront Park during the Portland Rose Festival Association's annual carnival and exhibition and to allow law enforcement authorities to plan for such event during the dates herein specified, therefore, an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
