#### ORDINANCE NO.

### 149599

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to William H. Baker to construct and maintain a structural driveway in the street area of N.W. 4th Street between N.W. 105th and N.W. 107th Avenues, at a permit fee of \$225.00, repealing Ordinance No. 149112, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Section 17.44.010 of the City Code requires Council approval for construction of any structure constructed in the street right of way that exceeds the dimensions of those that the City Engineer is authorized to grant by permit.
- William H. Baker, who is the owner of the property at 10512 and 10514 N.W. 4th Street, has requested permission to construct and maintain a structural driveway in the street area adjacent thereto.
- 3. The reason for said driveway is to provide access to the dwelling to be built at said address.
- The proposed driveway, under certain conditions, will not be detrimental to the public interest.
- 5. A change in the dwelling designed for the property described herein requires a change in location of the structural driveway previously authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A revocable permit is granted to William H. Baker, 2000 Jolie Ponte Road, West Linn, Oregon 97068, permittee, to construct and maintain a structural driveway, as approved by the City Engineer, in the street area adjacent to Lot 2, Block 3, Clark Terrace Addition, and located as shown on the plan marked "Exhibit A" attached to and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance, subject to the following conditions:
  - This permit is for the use of the street area only, and shall not exempt the permittee from obtaining any license or permit required by the City Code or Ordinances for any act to be performed under this permit, nor shall this permit waive the provisions of any City Code, Ordinance, or the City Charter, except as herein stated.

- (2) This permit is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council and no expenditure of money or lapse of time, or other act or thing, shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the permittee any vested or other right. Upon revocation of this permit by the Council, the permittee shall within 30 days remove the driveway and restore the street area as required by and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.
- (3) The permittee shall pay the permit fee of \$225.00 required by Section 17.24.020 of the City Code.
- (4) The permittee shall reimburse the City for the cost of filing by the City Auditor of a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Records Division of Multnomah County.
- (5) This permit is personal to the permittee and shall not run with the land.
- (6) The permittee shall hold the City of Portland, the City Engineer, and each and all of the officers and employees of the City free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property which may be occasioned by any construction, maintenance, and/or use of the street area under the permit hereby granted.
- (7) The permittee shall protect the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees by providing insurance as follows: Bodily injury \$100,000 for one claimant, \$300,000 for one occurrence. Property damage \$50,000 for one claimant, \$300,000 for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times and this permit revoked without further action by the Council if said insurance is permitted to lapse, or be cancelled or, for any other reason, become inoperative.
- Section 2. Ordinance No. 149112 entitled "An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to William H. Baker to construct and maintain a structural driveway in the street area of N.W. 4th Street between N.W. 105th and N.W. 107th Avenues, at a permit fee of \$225.00, and declaring an emergency.", passed by the Council January 31, 1980, is hereby repealed.
- Section 3. This Ordinance will not become effective until the permittee has filed with the City Auditor a document, which has been approved by the City Attorney, accepting the terms and conditions hereof.

## ORDINANCE No.

Section 4. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will result in an unnecessary hardship of uncertainty on the part of the applicant as to the status of the requested permit for construction of a structural driveway; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
