

ORDINANCE NO. 149602

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to the YWCA, 1111 Southwest Tenth Avenue, to place and maintain bicycle racks on the public sidewalk adjacent to their property, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

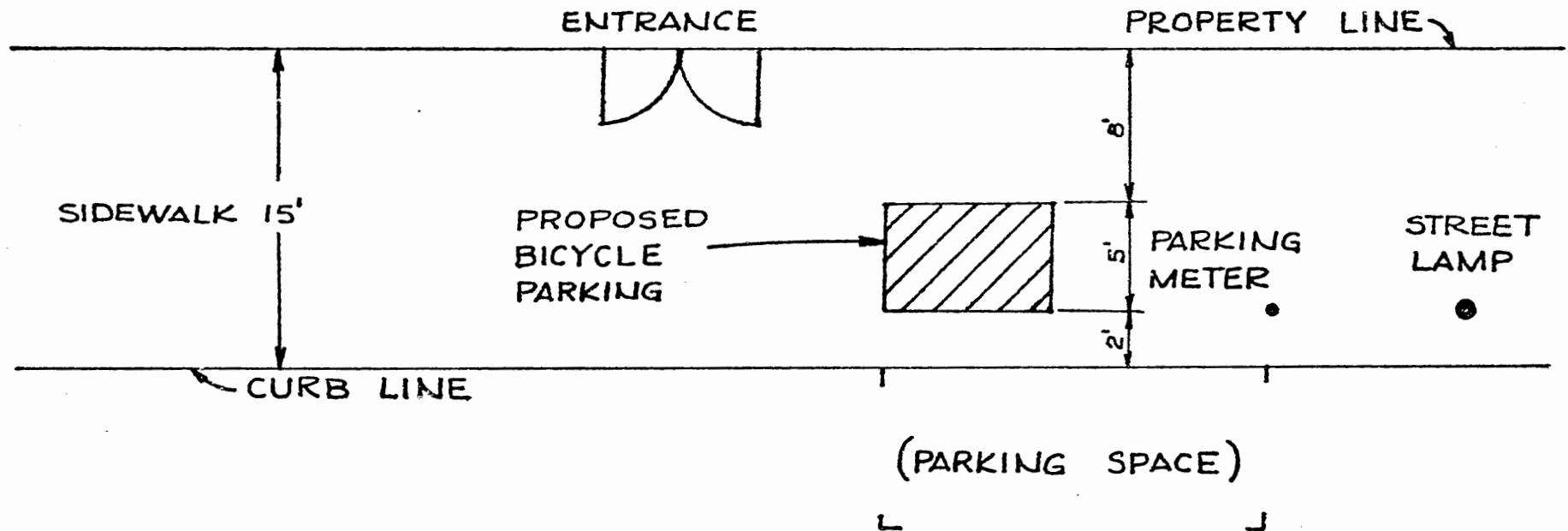
1. The YWCA has requested, in writing, permission to install bicycle racks in front of their building at 1111 Southwest Tenth Avenue.
2. The YWCA will provide adequate insurance coverage for such an installation.
3. There is currently no secure bicycle rack within four blocks of the proposed location.
4. The City Engineer has specified the exact placement of such bicycle racks to ensure that pedestrian traffic is not impeded.
5. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Program has reviewed this location and found it to be the most desirable placement for reasons of theft prevention, public safety, and convenience to users.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- A. A revocable permit to be granted to the YWCA, 1111 Southwest Tenth Avenue, to place and maintain bicycle racks in the public sidewalk at the location shown in Exhibit A and described below.
 - 1) On the west sidewalk of Southwest Tenth Avenue north of the entrance to 1111 Southwest Tenth Avenue.
- B. Such permit will be subject to the following conditions:
 - 1) Bicycle racks shall not extend more than seven (7) feet from the curb line.
 - 2) The YWCA agrees to maintain the bicycle racks in working order.
 - 3) The YWCA shall hold harmless the City, its officers and employees, and shall indemnify the City, its officers and employees for any claims for property damage or personal injury which may result from any activity carried on under the terms of the permit.
 - 4) The YWCA shall furnish and maintain sufficient public liability, product liability, and property damage insurance to protect the permittee and the City from all claims for property damage or personal injury, including death, which may arise from or in

connection with operations under the permit. Such insurance shall provide coverage of not less than \$100,000 for bodily injury for each person, \$300,000 for each occurrence, and \$300,000 for property damage per occurrence. This insurance shall be without prejudice to coverage otherwise existing therein, and shall name as additional insureds the City of Portland, its officers and employees, and shall further provide the policy shall not terminate or be cancelled prior to the completion of the contract without thirty days written notice to the Auditor of the City.


- 5) This permit may be revoked at any time by decision of the City Council and is automatically revoked without further action by the City Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled, or becomes inoperative for any reason.


Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists in order that the bicycle racks may be installed without needless delay. Now, therefore, this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage by the Council.
