

ORDINANCE NO. 149604

An Ordinance transferring within the Exposition-Recreation Commission Budget for the Civic Stadium for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980 the sum of \$82,700 from Part-Time Labor, the sum of \$11,400 from Benefits, the sum of \$76,900 from External Commodities and the sum of \$534,700 from General Operating Contingency, to Improvements (\$695,700) and Equipment (\$10,000), and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. A budget transfer is necessary to cover Exposition-Recreation Commission expenditures for the Civic Stadium for recontouring, engineering and the warning track, engineering services and construction of the commissary, engineering study of the west berm, construction of the marquee, west slope reinforcement and southwest wall investigation.
2. By Resolution passed on April 23, 1980, the Exposition-Recreation Commission authorized the transfer of a total of \$705,700 from Part-Time Labor, Benefits, External Commodities and General Operating Contingency, to Improvements and Equipment within the Civic Stadium Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980.
3. Adequate funds exist in the expenditure codes referred to to cover these expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. To cover the following Exposition-Recreation Commission expenditures for Civic Stadium:

A.	Stadium field work (recontouring, engineering, warning track)	\$360,700
B.	Engineer and Construct Commissary	140,000
C.	Engineering Study of West Berm	40,000
D.	Marquee	10,000
E.	West Slope Reinforcement	125,000
F.	S.W. Wall Investigation	30,000



Section 2. The Council declares:


