

## ORDINANCE NO. 149608

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of \$10,142 from the Hydroelectric Power Construction Fund, to the Fleet Operating Fund, increasing the appropriation of the Bureau of Fleet Management by \$10,142 for the purchase of compact sedans, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Hydroelectric Power requires three (3) additional Concord sedans in order to provide transportation.
2. The Bureau of Hydroelectric Power has funds available in the 1979-80 budget which may be allocated for this purchase.
3. That transfer of funds and increase in appropriation is necessary to allow the purchase of compact sedans by the Bureau of Fleet Management for assignment to the Bureau of Hydroelectric Power.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Funds are transferred and appropriations increased as follows:


