ORDINANCE NO. 149610

An Ordinance authorizing the acceptance of Grant No. 80-76, Revision #1, in the amount of \$752,262, from the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs for social services to the elderly through Title III-B of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended, under the Human Resources Bureau, for the period from September 1, 1979, through June 30, 1980, amending the City Budget by increasing appropriations by \$249,054, transferring funds, adjusting line items, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Pursuant to Ordinance No. 147721, Grant Application to the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs was authorized in the amount of \$2,742,783 for aging services under the Area Agency on Aging;
- Pursuant to Ordinance No. 149405, the City Accepted from the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs, Grant No. 80-76 in the amount of \$503,208 available under Title III-B of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended, to continue social services to the elderly in Portland/Multnomah County;
- 3. The Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs has determined that additional funds are available to Portland/Multnomah County under Title III-B of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended;
- 4. Local required match is required in the amount of \$91,880; \$32,758 of which will be provided by the eight District Service Centers in the form of a cash match, and the balance of \$59,122 provided by City General Funds which has already been budgeted by the Human Resources Bureau;
- 5. Indirect costs are included at the rate of 7% in the amount of \$2,786 against allowable costs.
- 6. It is, therefore, appropriate for the Mayor and the Auditor to accept, on behalf of the City, Grant No. 80-76, Revision #1, in the amount of \$752,262, from the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs for social services to the elderly through Title III-B of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended, under the Human Resources Bureau, for the period from September 1, 1979, through June 30, 1980, as set forth in Exhibit "A", amending the City Budget by increasing appropriations by \$249,054, transferring funds, and adjusting line items.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City, Grant No. 80-76, Revision #1 in the amount of \$752,262, from the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs for social services to the elderly through Title III-B of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended, under the Human Resources Bureau, for the period September 1, 1979 through June 30, 1980 as set forth in exhibit "A", amending the City Budget by increasing appropriations by \$249,054, transferring funds and adjusting line items.
- b. The Fiscal Year 1979-80 Budget is hereby amended by increasing appropriations and transferring funds, as follows:
