

ORDINANCE NO. 149612

An Ordinance transferring \$1,500 within the General Fund from Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures, to the Bureau of Fire, Prevention Division, to fund expenditures related to the U. S. Fire Administration Electrical Fire Investigation study, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the Consumer Protection Safety Commission, which has identified electrical deficiencies as a major cause of fire in one and two family residences, has contracted with the United States Fire Administration to conduct in depth investigations of electrically caused fires.
2. That the U. S. Fire Administration has selected ten (10) cities to participate in the program and has provided specialized training to fire investigators and electrical inspectors.
3. That the Portland Bureau of Fire has been selected to participate in the program and assigned personnel have already received training from the U. S. Fire Administration.
4. That the Portland Fire Bureau will conduct nineteen (19) investigations through FY 80-81 for which the United States Fire Administration will reimburse the City of Portland \$250 at the conclusion of each inspection for a total of \$4,750.
5. That during the remainder of FY 79-80 the Bureau of Fire anticipates completing six (6) of the nineteen (19) investigations.
6. That in order to complete these investigations as required, the Bureau of Fire will incur additional expenditures for photography equipment, supplies and overtime. That the transfer of \$1,500 is required to meet anticipated expenditures for the remainder of FY 1979-80.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City of Portland FY 1979-80 Budget is amended as follows:


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
