### ORDINANCE NO. 149626

An Ordinance accepting a grant totaling \$19,235 in aid of funding of the Police Productivity Index Project, authorizing a contract with the United States Office of Personnel Management, transferring appropriations for Fiscal Year 1979-80, transferring funds for the grant award, creating one position of Police Officer and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 149300, the City made application to the United States Office of Personnel Management for a grant to aid in funding the Police Productivity Index Project.
- 2. The grant has been approved and should be accepted.
- 3. The project cost is funded at \$40,381 of which the Federal share is \$19,235 and \$21,146 is required as local share, which local share is provided by existing resources of the Bureau of Police and \$5,000 from the Bureau of Personnel Services.
- 4. That one (1) position of Police Officer included in the approved grant award needs to be created.
- 5. That the grant award covers the period from May 1, 1980 to April 30, 1981.
- 6. That this ordinance appropriates resources necessary for the operation of the project for the remainder of FY 79-80 and that the Bureau of Police will return to Council after July 1, 1980 for the appropriation of the remaining grant resources for FY 80-81.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Auditor and the Commissioner-in-charge to accept the award and execute the contract with the United States Office of Personnel Management in the amount of \$19,235.

b. A transfer of appropriations for FY 79-80 and transfer of funds for the grant award is authorized as follows:

c. That one (1) position of Police Officer (5128) is created with a salary rate in accordance with the current Compensation Plan.

The Council declares that an emergency exists in that acceptance of the grant award should occur immediately and delay in the appropriation of funds may result in loss of funding for this project and because the position to be created is immediately required in order that the new functions may be carried out without delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
