

Ordinance No. 149786

EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, on June 17, 1980, the President of the Council issued an Executive Order designated Ordinance 149778 establishing a 20 miles per hour speed limit during the present state of emergency, or until the Order should be recinded or amended; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Quality has informed the City that 20 miles per hour speed limit no longer is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is presently unavailable to perform the duties of office under the provisions of Chapter 15.08 of the City Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

The Executive Order dated June 17, 1980 designated Ordinance No. 149778 is rescinded effective 1:30 p.m. June 20, 1980
