

ORDINANCE NO. 149790

An Ordinance adopting the provisions of the Executive Order dated June 18, 1980 regarding the collection, and removal or storage, of loose volcanic ash from parking lots (designated Ordinance No. 149783); and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

(1) By Executive Order dated June 18, 1980, the President of the Council established certain requirements regarding the collection, and removal or storage, of loose volcanic ash from parking lots.

(2) It is desirable that the requirements be adopted by the Council in ordinance form.

(3) It is desirable that certain barricading procedures be authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. As used herein, "parking lot" means a place for off-street parking of operable passenger automobiles owned by customers, employees, tenants, or patrons of businesses, industries, places of public assembly, apartment dwellings as defined in City Code Section 13.12.090, automobile service stations as defined in City Code Section 13.12.100, and other similar uses.

b. It shall be unlawful for a person to own or operate a public or private parking lot in the City of Portland unless the person has collected, and removed or stored, all loose volcanic ash from the parking lot surface.

c. Any owner or operator of a public or private parking lot in the City of Portland that has not complied with Section 2 of this Ordinance hereby is prohibited from using or permitting the use of, other than for purposes of clean-up, the parking lot without first having collected, and removed or stored, all loose volcanic ash from the parking lot surface.

d. City personnel authorized to issue citations for violations of this ordinance also are authorized to barricade any parking lot surface from which loose volcanic ash has not been collected, and removed or stored. It shall be unlawful for any person other than such authorized City personnel to remove any such barricade.



e. Violation of Section b, c, or d of this Ordinance shall be punishable, upon conviction thereof, by fine of not more than \$500.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary to have the volcanic ash removed from parking lots as quickly as possible; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its enactment by the Council.
