

ORDINANCE NO. 149791

An Ordinance authorizing the Building Inspection Director, the Fire Marshal, and the City Engineer and their designees, to make inspections and issue citations for violations of the Executive Order dated June 18, 1980 and the Ordinance dated June 23, 1980 regarding the collection, and removal or storage, of loose volcanic ash from parking lots; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

(1) By Executive Order dated June 18, 1980 and by Ordinance dated June 23, 1980, the City has required the owners and operators of parking lots to collect, and remove or store, loose volcanic ash from their parking lot surfaces.

(2) The Bureau of Police does not have sufficient personnel to enforce fully the Executive Order and the Ordinance.

(3) Personnel of the Bureau of Buildings, the Bureau of Fire, and the City Engineer's office are qualified to make inspections and issue citations for violations of the Executive Order and Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

(a) Persons designated to the City Auditor in writing by the Buildings Inspections Director, the Fire Marshal, and the City Engineer shall be special police officers of the City and shall so serve, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3.20.090 of the City Code, which provides that special police shall not be paid by the City. As special police officers, the designated persons shall have authority to make inspections and to issue citations for violations of the Executive Order dated June 18, 1980 and the Ordinance dated June 23, 1980 regarding the collection, and removal or storage, of loose volcanic ash from parking lots, and to this extent, they shall exercise full police power and authority. Persons so designated shall not be subject to the requirements of Chapter 3.74 of the City Code.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary to have the volcanic ash removed from parking lots


