These rates are higher than those originally quoted to you, since the previous rates were based on fringe benefit rates lower than those dictated by City Code.

Based on these rates, the Police Bureau is billing Tri-Met \$3,454.40 for services rendered by the Police Sergeant from May 13, 1980 to June 4, 1980.

The Police Bureau will send you a billing after each payroll period using the rates above, until the Police Sergeant's services are no longer needed by Tri-Met.

ORDINANCE NO. 149806

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of \$5,200 within the General Fund from Operating Contingency, Unforeseen Reimburseable Expenditures, to the Bureau of Police to provide funds for overtime and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That a letter of agreement, designated Exhibit "A", was signed between Doug Capps, Director, Management Services, Tri-Met, and Doug Fenstermaker, Director, Office of Technical Support, Bureau of Police, whereby the Bureau of Police will provide the services of a Police Sergeant on a temporary basis to Tri-Met.
- 2. That Management Services, Tri-Met, agreed to may the Bureau of Police the actual costs of said services which is estimated to amount to \$5,200 for the period beginning May 13, 1980 through the end of the fiscal year on June 30, 1980.
- 3. That said services are being provided and that the agreed to costs will be paid to the Treasurer of the City of Portland.
- 4. That the revenue derived from this letter of agreement is required as a resource by the Bureau of Police to provide appropriations to offset the increased expenditure in overtime.
- 5. That within the General Fund, \$5,200 should be transferred from Operating Contingency, Unforeseen Reimburseable Expenditures, to the Bureau of Police to provide for overtime.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That appropriations be transferred within the General Fund as follows:
