ORDINANCE No. 149810

An Ordinance creating one position of Clerk III and abolishing one position of Clerk II within the Bureau of Facilities Management and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

 That because of changing activities in the Bureau of Facilities Management, the duties and responsibilities of an existing Clerk II position have increased substantially.

2. That because of this, a Civil Service audit of this position was performed.

- 3. That the Bureau of Personnel services, after reviewing this position, has recommended the reclassification of the position from Clerk II to Clerk III.
- 4. That this reclassification should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. One position of Clerk II (Job Class No. 0112) is hereby abolished.
- b. One position of Clerk III (Job Class No. 0114) is hereby created.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in passage of this Ordinance will create an administrative burden. Therefore this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
