

**ORDINANCE No. 149836**

An Ordinance transferring \$28,233 within the Water Fund to cover extraordinary overtime expenditures, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Water Works has been requested by the Department of Public Works to assist in washing volcanic ash from City streets and will include the last two week-ends of the current fiscal year.
2. The Bureau of Water Works has responded to these requests with a significant portion of the work performed on overtime status at an overtime cost of \$13,233.
3. The two week-ends of work which are requested will involve overtime status at an anticipated cost of \$15,000.
4. The above described overtime work was unrelated to the operation and maintenance of the water system and not anticipated in the preparation of the 1979-80 budget.
5. The above described overtime work is a direct result of the Mt. St. Helens eruption of June 12, 1980.
6. As overtime is a controlled line item, the transfer is necessary to ensure that an over-expenditure does not occur.
7. The Bureau of Water Works is in need of additional overtime appropriations and the Commissioner-in-Charge recommends a transfer of \$28,233 from Water Fund Contingencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A transfer of appropriation in the amount of \$28,233 be made within the Water Fund (number 05) from Contingencies, BUC 17400155, Object 710, to Construction and Maintenance, Field Support Overtime, BUC 18400081, Project 0184, Object 140.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists in order that the necessary appropriation transfer may be made without undue delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
