An ordinance transferring \$8,000 within the General Fund from Bureau of Traffic Engineering, Parking Patrol RU 583, Full Time Employees Obj. 110 \$4,000, Benefits Obj. 170 \$4,000, to Bureau of Traffic Engineering RU 580 Obj. 330 \$1,000 and RU 581 Obj. 210 \$3,000 and Obj. 320 \$4,000, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Traffic Engineering requires \$8,000 additional within its budget for:
 - (a) \$1,000 is required by Administration for the cost of parking meter hoods
 - (b) \$7,000 is required by the Operations Division to cover the City's share in the cost of a railroad crossing protection device at N. W. Doan and St. Helens, and for repair services on traffic counters.
- 2. The additional appropriation should be provided by transfer from within the Bureau budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. \$8,000 is transferred within the General Fund from the Bureau of Traffic Engineering, Parking Patrol RU 583, Full Time Employees Obj. 110 \$4,000, Benefits Obj. 170 \$4,000 to Bureau of Traffic Engineering RU 580 Obj. 330 \$1,000 and RU 581 Obj. 210 \$3,000 and Obj. 320 \$4,000

From 58300012 - 0051 \$8,000 to 58000019 - 0005 \$1,000 58100102 - 0600 \$3,000 58100102 - 0600 \$4,000

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the adjustments herein are necessary to assure that appropriations are sufficient to support the FY 1979-80 expenditures, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from
