ORDINANCE NO. 149866

An Ordinance authorizing an application to the United States of America, Department of Health and Human Services, for a grant estimated at \$50,000 in aid of a demonstration project in the education of children toward the prevention of child sexual abuse, authorizing contract(s) and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

. . .

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Department of Health and Human Services makes grants to local governments in aid of the prevention of child sexual abuse.
- 2. The Portland Police Bureau provides services in the area of the prevention of sexual assault and could further the City's efforts therein by a grant in aid of said services.
- 3. The project cost is estimated at \$50,000, none of which is required as a local match.
- 4. Should the City receive the grant, it will be obligated to comply with the regulations of the Department of Health and Human Services.
- 5. Should the grant be successfully carried out, the City will be eligible for an additional \$50,000 for the second year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner-in-charge shall make application to the United State of America, Department of Health and Human Services, for a grant of \$50,000 in aid of the prevention of child sexual abuse.
- b. Should the described grant be approved, a contract or grant agreement is authorized.
- c. The Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to provide assurances regarding the use of the grant as may be required by the Department of Health and Human Services.
- d. The Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for receipt, expenditure and accounting for the grant project.
- e. Expenditures under this grant are not authorized until the Department of Health and Human Services has approved the grant; the Council has specifically appropriated the funds; and the system of accountability has been established by the Bureau of Financial Affairs.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because regulations governing the grant application require immediate application, and delay in application may result in the loss of opportunity to receive the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
