

RESOLUTION No. 33895

WHEREAS, the FY 1984-85 Facilities Lease Program of the City of Portland includes financing for the construction of new fire stations in N.E. Portland and the Rivergate Industrial District of North Portland, and

WHEREAS, increased construction costs combined with the projected rate of development in outer N.E. Portland dictate that construction of the new N.E. Station should be postponed, and

WHEREAS, outer N.E. Portland presently receives an adequate level of fire protection service from existing facilities including a temporary station located on N.E. 156th; and

WHEREAS, the FY 1985-86 Approved Budget requires the elimination of eighteen positions through the consolidation of Engine Station 17 located on Hayden Island with Boat 3 and the proposed Rivergate Station at a new facility to be located adjacent to the Columbia Slough, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau requires the relocation of Engine 16 in order to improve fire protection services in the Northwest and North areas of Portland, and

WHEREAS, financing of the new consolidated station and the new Engine Station 16 can be secured through the reallocation of funds authorized within the FY 1984-85 Facilities Lease Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, that:

Section 1. The Fire Bureau in coordination with the Office of Fiscal Administration will initiate necessary actions to reallocate funds under the FY 1984-85 Facilities Lease Program in order to finance the construction of a new consolidated facility in the vicinity of the Columbia Slough and for the relocation of Engine 16.

Section 2. The Fire Bureau will proceed immediately with the necessary actions to construct a new facility in the vicinity of the Columbia Slough and a new facility for the relocation of Engine 16.
