## NOTICE/RESULTS OF NOMINATIONS FOR POLICE TRUSTEE ELECTION

An election to seat one member from the Portland Police Bureau for the vacated term of Police Trustee Brian Hunzeker (for the remainder of his term, expiring December 31, 2021) as a member of the Board of Trustees was scheduled to be held using a vote-by-mail process with ballots being mailed on April 16, 2021. All Police members of the Fire and Police Disability and Retirement Fund are hereby notified that:

Chris Kulp was the only candidate running for the Police trustee position. Pursuant to Section 5.2.04(A)(3)(d) of the Administrative Rules: "If only one Active Member is nominated in any election, the election shall not be held. The Director shall determine and certify to the Board that the nominee was unopposed. The nominee so certified shall be declared elected in accordance with the procedures set out in this section of the Administrative Rules."

Therefore, please be advised that **CHRIS KULP** is elected as Police trustee to the FPDR Board of Trustees for the remainder of the vacated position expiring on December 31, 2021.
