An Ordinance authorizing the Human Resources Bureau, Training and Employment Division (TED) to accept a Department of Labor CETA Title IV Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) grant in the amount of \$1,441,023; reducing the TED budget in the amount of (\$252,381) in FY80-81; and declaring an emergency.


The City of Portland ordains:

### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That the Department of Labor has made CETA Title IV-SYEP funds in the amount of \$1,441,023 available to the Training and Employment Division.
- 2. The grant is for the purpose of operating the Summer Youth Employment Program for the period June 16, 1980, through August 22, 1980.
- The FY80-81 City budget contains appropriations in the amount of \$1,622,835 for SYEP, based on estimates made during the budget process.
- 4. This Ordinance will reduce appropriations in the amount of (\$252,381), (\$70,569) of the total having been spent in June, 1980, during the City's FY79-80 fiscal year, and (\$181,812) for a slightly lower than expected award from DOL.
- 5. There is no match required of the City for this grant.
- 6. Indirect costs will be charged at a rate of 3% of allowable costs.
- 7. It is therefore appropriate that the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Portland, accept Grant No. 41-0-010-SYEP in the amount of \$1,441,023 from the Department of Labor, as shown in Exhibit A and make appropriation adjustments as shown.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City, the \$1,441,023 grant awarded by the Department of Labor, as set forth in Exhibit A.
- b. The Finance Officer is hereby authorized to amend the FY80-81 City Budget, reducing resources and requirements as follows:
