To Whom it May Concern:

I have received several letters from the Bureau of Buildings. Neighborhood Division. Nuisance Removal. Concerning Removal of debris from my property on M.L.K. Blvd.

For the past five years we have been cleaning up debris from people using our property as a dump site.

This has cost me several hundred dollars. I think I may have found a solution for this problem. If the City would contract with a rubbish

Company to pick up trash for the City, we could eliminate this problem. If I may explain.

1. The City could have you pay for trash on the water bill.
2. The City could divide the rubbish companies into several sections of the City. The contract would last for two years, and then go up for bids. This way the City would not have to invest money by contracting to individual companies.
3. Three times a year the City would have the rubbish Co. do a major pick-up for old appliances, tires, scrap metal, furniture and etc. The major pick-ups would be part of the bid.

4. Each Home Owner, Business Landlord, and Tenants would have the responsibility to pay for water & trash.

5. This would eliminate the nuisance removal by 80%, and not use City funds for Clean-up. I hope you will consider this as positive thinking. I love this City and want the best for it!
