ORDINANCE NO. 150119

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to the Lloyd Corporation for a fireworks display on August 8, 1980, on a parking lot between 13th, 14th, Multnomah and Holladay Streets, as a feature of the Lloyd Center Birthday Anniversary at the Lloyd Shopping Center being held that day, under certain conditions and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That the Lloyd Corporation of Portland has heretofore filed a request for a revocable permit to have a fireworks display on a parking lot between 13th, 14th, Multnomah and Holladay Streets on August 8, 1980 at approximately 9:00 p.m. This fireworks display will be visible from Holladay Park and the surrounding parking lots where the Lloyd Center Birthday Celebration will be in progress that evening.
- 2. That under the provision of ORS, Chapter 480, the sale and use of fireworks in the State of Oregon are prohibited except under certain circumstances therein recited.
- 3. That the request has been approved by the Fire Marshal, as exofficio Assistant State Fire Marshal by provisions of ORS 476.060, who, under authority of ORS, Chapter 480, and pursuant to Section 21.44.250(b) of the Code of the City of Portland, has authority to grant a permit in the name of the State Fire Marshal.
- 4. That the Council further finds that by the provisions of the State Law permitting such displays, the same shall be under the supervision of the Chiefs of the Bureaus of Fire and Police.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the action of the Commissioner-in-charge of the issuing of the permit is ratified and that a revocable permit hereby is granted to Lloyd Corporation to stage a fireworks display on the Parking Lot between 13th, 14th, Multnomah and Holladay Streets on August 8, 1980 at approximately 9:00 p.m., as a feature of the Lloyd Center Birthday Anniversary that evening. In the event of inclement weather, alternate dates may be approved by the Fire Marshal's Office. Such display shall be under the control and supervision of the Chief of the Bureau of Police and the Fire Marshal, Bureau of Fire, and shall be staged in conformity with the regulations and limitations set forth in ORS Chapter 480, and the rules and regulations promulgated under authority of said chapter by the State Fire Marshal, and under the following conditions:
 - 1. The permittee shall have first filed with the Auditor of the City of Portland, on a form approved by the City Attorney, an insurance policy or certificate of insurance in the sum of \$1,000,000 for bodily injury and \$500,000 for property damage. Said insurance is to

protect the City of Portland, its officers, agents and employees.

- 2. Display to consist of ground and set pieces only. No aerial, sky rockets or mortors.
- 3. The display, handling, and transportation of fireworks display shall be under the direct supervision of John Sinclair, 2470 NW Westover, Portland, Oregon.
- 4. The permittee shall effectively supervise the fireworks display to prevent unauthorized persons from entering within the firing range of any fireworks device or within 50 feet of any shed, truck, or magazine in which fireworks are stored. Such area shall be roped off and security provided to prevent the entry of unauthorized persons into the area.
- 5. Firing platforms shall not be located closer than 150 feet from any audience or 200 feet from any combustible structure, occupied parking area, and 50 feet from the nearest aboveground power, telephone, or telegraph line or other overhead obstruction.

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- 6. The Chief of the Bureau of Police, the Chief of the Bureau of Fire, or the Fire Marshal, or their designated representatives, may stop or cancel the authorized display in the event conditions develop which might tend to endanger lives or property, or when the wind reaches a velocity of more than twenty (20) miles per hour.
- 7. Two Class 2A fire extinguishers shall be provided in the firing area, and personnel in the firing area shall be knowledgeable in their use and operation.
- 8. A minimum of eight (8) security personnel shall secure the display/ discharge and storage area.
- 9. Fire extinguishing equipment shall be provided by Lloyd Corporation of Portland, Oregon, in the firing area, with a fire watch for thirty (30) minutes following the display.
- 10. No smoking shall be allowed within 50 feet of the display firing area.
- 11. The fireworks are to be stored in a Class I magazine prior to and after the display. All unused shells are to be immediately returned to their magazine at the conclusion of the display and removed from the City within a six hour period.
- 12. A Chain link fence will be erected around the perimeter of the display area for crowd control.
- Section 2. This permit shall not be in force and effect until and unless the permittee shall have first filed with the Auditor of the City of Portland, in form approved by the City Attorney, a document in writing accepting the terms and conditions of this ordinance.

ORDINANCE No. Section 3.
