

ORDINANCE NO. 150848

An Ordinance transferring \$12,000 within the Housing and Community Development Fund and the General Fund in order to increase the Park Bureau's appropriation for design of Riverside Fishing Pier.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Brooklyn Neighborhood residents desire improved access to the banks of the Willamette River, which access is now restricted by McLoughlin Boulevard and lack of a pathway to the water.
2. An attitude survey authorized by Council found 72% of Brooklyn residents support construction of a crossing of McLoughlin Boulevard and 84% of these prefer an overpass to an underpass.
3. Since the bank is extremely steep in this area (S.E. Haig Street), it would be appropriate to construct a fishing pier to allow use and enjoyment of the river.
4. The Bureau of Streets and Structural Engineering is prepared to design the overpass and pathway to the pier to be funded in large part from Mt. Hood transfer funds. The Bureau seeks Council direction to proceed by a separate resolution to be heard concurrently with this ordinance.
5. The Park Bureau should coordinate design and construction of the fishing pier. The Bureau would require \$12,000 for design which should be appropriated from the Housing and Community Development Fund.
6. Funds for construction of the pier, currently estimated at \$125,000, will be requested in the 1981-82 budget from Housing and Community Development funds.
