ORDINANCE NO. **150855**

An Ordinance authorizing the loan of a surplus fire apparatus to the Oregon Air National Guard Fire Department at the Portland Air Base, subject to certain terms and conditions, providing for acceptance thereof, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that the Oregon Air National Guard Fire Department, by and through its commander, has requested the loan of a surplus fire apparatus for use in structural fire training of its fire fighters; that in order to continue to offer this training for the crash/fire fighters, the Air National Guard finds it necessary to secure fire equipment on a gratuitous basis; that the Chief of the Bureau of Fire advises that the Bureau has an apparatus which is surplus and which was to be taken off the line and sold; that the estimated value of the apparatus is \$3,000 and it would better serve the City's purpose to loan this equipment to the Air National Guard at no cost to the National Guard so as to enable it to continue to offer this training to its fire fighters in structural pumper operations; that the Commissioner-in-charge agrees with the recommendation of the Chief for the loan of this fire apparatus subject to certain terms and conditions, and that the loan should be authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, the loan of fire apparatus No. 90, 1951 Maxim Pumper No. 5315, City Inventory No. 34502, to the Oregon Air National Guard, is hereby authorized, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) That there is no charge for the Air National Guard to use the apparatus;
- (2) That the term of this loan shall be for a period not to exceed five (5) years, and subject to cancellation by the City of Portland at any time;
- (3) The Oregon Air National Guard agrees to assume maintenance and upkeep of the apparatus, normal deterioration excluded, but including the fuel, oil, batteries, tires, and other normal parts necessary to keep the apparatus and equipment in functional condition. The City of Portland will renegotiate the loan of this apparatus at the time of any major breakdown;
