

Proposed Referral Process for 30 PSH Units at Renaissance Commons

- 1) REACH notifies JOHS that a PSH Unit is going to become vacant
- 2) JOHS and PHB cross-reference current Preference Policy and Coordinated Access (CA) lists
- 3) JOHS develops “PSH Referral List” that includes households on both lists who meet the following criteria:
 - a) PSH eligible (disabling condition and experiencing long-term homelessness)
 - b) Desiring culturally specific services for Black or African American populations
- 4) PSH Referral List is prioritized in order of Preference Policy points
- 5) JOHS refers prioritized household to REACH and Coordinated Access partners reach out to household to offer support with the lease-up process
- 6) Every 3rd referral is identified by the Urban League to enable service continuity for households they are already working with who need PSH
- 7) If/once the PSH Referral List is exhausted, Urban League will make direct referrals into the PSH units
