*When an acceptance is required from a firm or corporation the Acceptance must be signed by an officer of the firm or corporation stating his or her official title, and corporations must affix the corporate seal.

An Ordinance authorizing the Pittock Mansion Society to use a portion of Pittock Acres Park on August 9, 1981 for a fund raising benefit automobile display authorizing the charging of admission, the serving of food and beverages subject to certain conditions and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the Pittock Mansion Society has requested use of a portion of Pittock Acres Park to hold a fund raising benefit display of Rolls Royce and Bentley automobiles on August 9, 1981.
2. That the Commissioner-in-Charge of the Bureau of Parks has reviewed such request and approved such use subject to certain conditions.
3. That because of the benefit to be derived by the City, by use of funds raised at such event for benefit of the Pittock Mansion, authorization to charge admission should be granted together with other conditions required by the Bureau of Parks for such usage.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

That permission is hereby granted to the Pittock Mansion Society for use of a portion of Pittock Acres Park for the purpose of a benefit display of automobiles on August 9, 1981 subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Pittock Mansion Society may charge an admission fee to the event which shall be collected by the Society.
2. A tour of the Pittock Mansion will be included in the price of the admission.
3. Seventy-five cents (\$0.75) of each admission charge shall be remitted to the City by the Pittock Mansion Society.

ORDINANCE No.

4. The serving of food and alcoholic beverages shall be permitted at such event to be served by a licensed caterer subject to all applicable provisions of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

5. Non-amplified music shall be allowed at such event.

6. Owners of the automobiles to be displayed at the event shall agree to hold the City, its officers and employees harmless from any claims for damage to such automobiles during the display, the form of such hold harmless agreement shall be approved by the City Attorney.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall not be effective until the Pittock Mansion Society has accepted and agreed to the terms and conditions of this Ordinance and filed such acceptance with the City Auditor.

Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary for the Pittock Mansion Society to make plans and financial commitments for the authorized event at the earliest possible time; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
