

ORDINANCE No. 151580

An Ordinance authorizing a transfer of appropriation within the Metropolitan Arts Commission between major object codes and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Metropolitan Arts Commission requires the purchase of an electric typewriter due to the lack of equipment for existing staff.
2. The appropriation is available within the FY 1980-81 budget in Office Supplies, line item 310, and Operating Supplies, line item 320.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

a. \$660.00 is transferred as follows:	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
37500666/310 (Office supplies)	\$210.00	
37500330/320 (Operating supplies)	450.00	
37500011/640 (Furniture and equipment)		\$660.00

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists, because the appropriation is needed immediately to purchase the typewriter for the Metropolitan Arts Commission; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council, and declaring an emergency.
