## ORDINANCE No. 151609

An Ordinance creating one position of Parking Patrol Deputy within the Bureau of Traffic Engineering Parking Patrol Division, transferring \$2,994 in appropriations from Unforeseen Reimbursables to the Bureau of Traffic Engineering and declaring an emergency.

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That the neighborhoods of Lair Hill and Gander Ridge have been established as permenant resident permit parking areas;
- 2. That one position of Parking Patrol Deputy is required to enforce the program in these two neighborhoods, to be funded by Multnomah County.
- 3. That one position was included in the Bureau's FY 81/82 budget for this purpose;
- 4. That this position is required immediately to enforce these areas until July 1, 1981.
- 5. That \$2,994 in appropriations should be transferred from Unforseen Reimburseables to the Bureau of Traffic Engineering to cover this position to the remainder of this fiscal year.
