ORDINANCE No. 151610

An Ordinance authorizing free play on the Municipal golf courses for members of the visiting "Rose Festival" Navy Fleet during the dates of Jume 5 through June 15, and declaring an emergency.

Section 1. The Council finds:

- I. The visit of the Navy ships to Portland during Rose Festival time is a tradition of long standing. The local golf courses and golf clubs have traditionally offered complimentary golf rounds to the members of the fleet in return for their contributions to the Rose Festival Program.
- 2. There have never been more than fifteen or sixteen members of the fleet take advantage of this opportunity.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Municipal golf course concessionaires be instructed to offer the free golf to the Fleet members upon presentation of proper identification; and, providing that those wishing to play call at least twenty-four hours in advance to make reservations.
- b. That any one course need not accept more than three foursomes of Navy Fleet players in one day.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in enactment of this ordinance would cause hardship in making arrangements for the above playing conditions. Therefore, this ordinance shall be imforce and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
