

**ORDINANCE No. 151614**

An ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to furnish five (5) Hi Cube type delivery vans for the Bureau of Fleet Management; authorizing a contract with the most favorable bidder; authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Five delivery vans are required by the Bureau of Fleet Management at an estimated cost of \$57,500 to be assigned to the Bureau of Maintenance.
2. Ordinance 151205 authorized the transfer of \$46,000 from the General Fund to the Fleet Operating Fund for purchase of 4 of the vans identified above. The fifth is a replacement vehicle and will be paid for from Fleet's replacement account.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using specifications filed in his office for the vans described above, and in the event that no satisfactory bids are received, shall re-advertise using the same basic specifications until satisfactory bids are received.
- b. Contracts are authorized with the most favorable bidders as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1980-81 Budget, Fleet Operating Fund, Bureau of Fleet Management, BUC 56200037, Expenditure Code 643 - Equipment, Motor Vehicles, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The City Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this purchase may result in additional expenses, and will unnecessarily deprive the intended Bureau the use of the new equipment; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
