

ORDINANCE No. 151644

An Ordinance transferring appropriation in the amount of \$109,000 within the General Fund from General Operating Contingency to Office of City Auditor in order to pay election expenses, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The 1980-81 budget of the City Auditor included only \$40,000 to cover estimated election costs for that fiscal year.

2. Actual election costs for fiscal year 1980-81 are:

1980 Primary costs billed after 7/1/80	\$13,254.
1980 General election	47,039.
1981 Special election - 2/17/81	52,094.
1981 Special election - 3/31/81	36,613.
Total	149,000.

3. In order to provide appropriation to pay all election expenses in 1980-81, it will be necessary to provide for a transfer of \$109,000 from General Operating Contingency to Office of City Auditor.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Appropriation in the amount of \$109,000 is hereby transferred within the General Fund from General Operating Contingency (20100010) to Office of City Auditor (33600178)(260).

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary that appropriation be provided to cover existing deficits and to pay outstanding bills with no unnecessary delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
