An Ordinance amending Contract No. 14767 with the North Portland Citizens Committee, Inc., for the operation of the Neighbors North office by extending the contract for the period of July 1, 1981 through June 30, 1982, providing for funding at a cost of \$47,398 and additional City printing costs of \$2,000, from the General Fund, Office of Neighborhood Associations and authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, providing for acceptance and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland, through the Office of Neighborhood Associations, has been contracting with the North Portland Citizens Committee, Inc. (hereinafter N.P.C.C.), for the operation of the Neighbors North office according to Contract No. 14767.
- 2 The contract should be extended for the next fiscal year.
- 3. The cost of the 1981-1982 Fiscal Year will be \$47,398, as itemized in Exhibit A attached, subject to such wage cost of living increase as the Council may adopt for the Fiscal Year 1981-1982. In addition, the City budget provides \$2,000 for printing through Central Services.
- 4. The appropriation is included within the budget of the General Fund, Office of Neighborhood Associations, as previously approved by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Contract No. 14767 with N.P.C.C. for the operation of the Neighbors North office is hereby amended by extending the contract for the period July 1, 1981 through June 30, 1982, by providing funds in the amount of \$47,398 as itemized in Exhibit A attached and by reference made a part hereof. In addition to the funds shown in this contract, the Neighbors North office is hereby authorized to spend up to \$2,000 for City printing services. Expenditures of these sums shall be tallied on the City's Financial Management system reports in order to conserve staff time in billing procedures. All other terms and conditions remain the same.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants in accordance with the contract as amended payable to North Portland Citizens Committee, Inc., 7508 N. Hereford, which shall be charged to the Office of Neighborhood Associations Object Code 260.

- c. Additionally, the contracted amount shall be increased by any wage cost of living increase adopted by City Council for the Fiscal Year 1981-1982.
- d. This amendment shall be effective upon the acceptance of terms of this ordinance in writing by N.P.C.C. filed with the City Auditor in form approved by the City Attorney.

Section 2. So that there will be no interruption in the continuity of the contract, the Council declares that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be subject to Paragraph D above, in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
