An Ordinance accepting a gift of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) from the Altrusa Club of Portland for the purpose of purchasing a Life-Pac or other emergency medical equipment for the Bureau of Fire, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That the Altruca Club of Portland, a professional women's service organization, has donated to the Bureau of Fire the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for the purpose of purchasing a Life-Pac or other emergency medical equipment.
- 2. That these funds shall be used to purchase a Life-Pac or other emergency medical equipment for the rescue units of the Portland Fire Bureau.
- That no restrictions or obligations are assumed by the City by accepting this gift.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The sum of four thousand dollars donated by the Altrusa Club of Portland for the purchase of a Life-Pac or other emergency medical equipment is accepted.
- b. The fiscal year 1980-81 budget is hereby amended by an increase in appropriation as follows:
