An Ordinance accepting a gift of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) from the Altrusa Club of Portland for the purpose of purchasing a Life-Pac or other emergency medical equipment for the Bureau of Fire, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the Altrusa Club of Portland, a professional women's service organization, has donated to the Bureau of Fire the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for the purpose of purchasing a Life-Pac or other emergency medical equipment.
2. That these funds shall be used to purchase a Life-Pac or other emergency medical equipment for the rescue units of the Portland Fire Bureau.
3. That no restrictions or obligations are assumed by the City by accepting this gift.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The sum of four thousand dollars donated by the Altrusa Club of Portland for the purchase of a Life-Pac or other emergency medical equipment is accepted.
- b. The fiscal year 1980-81 budget is hereby amended by an increase in appropriation as follows:
