ORDINANCE No. 151699

An Ordinance transferring \$9,977.50 from General Fund Operating Contingency to the Office of General Services for professional services related to the development of a condominium ownership of the Justice Center by the City and Multnomah County, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That the Justice Center now under construction will be jointly occupied by the City and Multnomah County.
- 2. That the Justice Center is being constructed on land jointly owned by the City and Multnomah County, and that title to the structure and management responsibilities must be assigned.
- 3. That the specialized services of an attorney and a surveyor are required to prepare the documents necessary to establish the Justice Center as a condominium.
- 4. That the costs for these services will be jointly shared by the City and County.
- 5. That it is necessary to transfer appropriation in the amount of \$9,977.50 from General Fund Operating Contingency to the Office of General Services to pay the City's share of the professional service costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

a. Appropriations are transferred as follows:
