ORDINANCE NO. 151700

An Ordinance authorizing the acceptance of Grant No. 81-13, Amendment No. 1, in the sum of \$780,418 from the State Office of Elderly Affairs, to continue social services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County under Title III-B, Older Americans Act of 1965, as Amended, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, amending the FY 1980-81 City Budget by increasing appropriations in the amount of \$157,176; transferring funds; adjusting line items; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 150069, approved by Council July 23, 1980, Grant No. 81-13 was accepted in the amount of \$623,242 to continue social services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County under the Human Resources Bureau.
2. The Office of Elderly Affairs has awarded \$157,176 in carryover funds from FY 1979-80, in accordance with the FY 1980-81 Annual Plan.
3. Match is required in the amount of \$130,905 and will be provided by social service contractors and City/County General Funds budgeted for FY 1980-81.
4. It is, therefore, appropriate for the Mayor to accept on behalf of the City, Grant No. 81-13, Amendment No. 1, in the sum of \$780,418 from the State Office of Elderly Affairs, to continue social services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County under Title III-B, Older Americans Act of 1965, as Amended, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, as set forth in Exhibit "A", amending the FY 1980-81 City Budget by increasing appropriations in the amount of \$157,176, transferring funds, and adjusting line items.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City, Grant No. 81-13, Amendment No. 1, in the sum of \$780,418 from the Office of Elderly Affairs, to continue social services for the elderly in Portland/Multnomah County, under Title III-B, Older Americans Act of 1965, as Amended, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, as set forth in Exhibit "A", amending the FY 1980-1981 City Budget by increasing appropriations in the amount of \$157,176, transferring funds, and adjusting line items.
- b. The City Budget is hereby amended as follows:


