Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this ordinance is to modify the terms in the collective bargaining agreement to provide Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class A training at PBOT Maintenance and Operations for Sharon Allen, Nicole Graybill, and Zuleyma Carballo-Figueroa, employees in the Utility Worker I classification within PBOT Streetcar.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class A training has an average cost of \$3,000 a person. The bureau is estimated to spend \$9,000 from the existing budget for training employees in the Utility Worker I classification within PBOT Streetcar. The City will pay for the expense of the trainings and for the DOT physical, however, time spend in training is voluntary and not paid by the City. Employees participating in the CDL training will be required to obtain a permit and complete ant necessary tests prior to the start of training at their own cost.
