Legislation title: Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$9,351.10 and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the 2022 Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Plan for commercial motor vehicle inspections by the Police Bureau sworn personnel (Ordinance)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance authorizes acceptance of this award. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) notified the City that it will award a grant in the amount of \$9,351.10 to be reimbursed during the grant period of July 1, 2021—September 30, 2022.

The goal of the Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Plan (MCSAP) is to reduce accidents involving commercial motor vehicles (CMV) and to reduce injuries and fatalities resulting from accidents involving CMVs. On-road vehicle inspections focusing on conditions that would require the CMV or CMV operator to be taken out of service can reduce truck-at-fault crashes on Oregon highways. Because the on-road vehicle inspections would be precipitated by a valid traffic stop of the CMV, the on-road vehicle inspections may also curb unsafe driving actions of CMV operators that would be subject to a traffic citation or written warning.

The City has participated in this grant program since 2012, which supports Vision Zero.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This action will increase the Police Bureau's Grant Fund appropriation by \$9,351.10 for FY 2021-2022.

Community impacts and community involvement:

There are no legal or controversial issues. There is no voluntary citizen participation. There are no links to current City policies. The City and ODOT agree that inspections conducted on Interstate 5, 205, designated high-crash corridors within the official limits of the city of Portland qualify for CMV grant reimbursement.
