Emergency Ordinance

*Authorize application to the Department of Homeland Security for a grant not to exceed \$3 million for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program to fund equipment and training

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Department of Homeland Security, through its Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has offered the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program since 2000.
- 2. The AFG Program focuses on enhancing public safety with respect to fire and fire-related hazards, providing financial assistance for critical training, equipment, enhancing operational efficiencies, foster interoperability, and support community resilience.
- 3. On November 8, 2021, AFG released the FY 2021 Notice of Funding Opportunity # DHS-21-GPD-044-00-98.
- 4. Portland Fire & Rescue has identified critically needed resources that meet the AFG Program's High Priority Objectives for FY 2021.
- 5. The application submission deadline is December 17, 2021.
- 6. Local match of 10% is required and will be supplied by the FY 2022-23 and 2023-24 budget of Portland Fire & Rescue.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- A. The Portland Fire & Rescue Chief is hereby authorized to make application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for a grant in the amount not to exceed \$3,000,000.
- B. The Chief is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- C. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
