ORDINANCE NO. 151828

An Ordinance transferring \$120,712 within the General Fund from General Fund Operating Contingency, Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures, to the Office of General Services, transferring \$4,253 between line items within the budget of the Office of General Services to prevent overexpenditures at the end of FY 1980-81, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That telephone rate increases approved by the Oregon Public Utilities Commissioner in September, 1980 will increase the City's telephone bill by an estimated \$55,712 for FY 1980-81.
- 2. That the current Office of General Services' budget for the Public Service Building does not contain sufficient appropriation for all of the reimbursable expenditures incurred by OGS during FY 1980-81.
- 3. That additional appropriation in the amount of \$65,000 is required for these expenditures. The Oregon Public Buildings Corporation has already reimbursed the City for these expenditures.
- 4. That an appropriation transfer of \$3,000 within the 1980-81 budget of the Office of General Services from professional services to personal services is required because of higher than anticipated requirements for part-time accounting support.
- 5. That an additional appropriation transfer of \$1,253 is required within the 1980-81 budget of the Office of General Services for furnishings for the Records Center which were appropriated in materials and services, but charged to capital outlay.

NCW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:
