The first time I called about the potholes was another time I hit a large pothole on Foster and hit Really hard. I am not so sure that there isn't damage done to my car underneath somewhere. I really am hoping that is not the case.

When I called the first time you may remember the message because I was so upset and said our roads are worse than a 3rd world country and I did go on and on and on. Hopefully you will recognize these two calls I left because apparently they are important to my claim. At the time I called I did not know I could even make a claim. I was told this on the 4^{th,} last week when I hit the pothole that was so big and DEEP I was shocked. When I called, I was angry and told the receptionist that I had called before etc. She then explained I could file a claim. I am hoping you are paying some of the claims received especially from Foster Rd. People are hitting those holes daily and I am sure there has been a lot of damage done to others vehicles. I saw on the news we were allotted 3 million dollars to use for roads and repairs from the Covid Fund. I am hoping you will use that wisely and fix some of the HORRIBLE roads we have here in Portland.

I have lived here my entire life (66 yrs) and never imaged I would see our once beautiful city become what it is now. It looks like something I would see in a war zone. Its horrible and Portland does not deserve to now become a City no one wants to come to visit anymore. I know several people who are leaving the area for just these reasons.

Sorry I got carried away in this note. It's the frustration of watching Beautiful City of Portland disappear.
