

ORDINANCE NO.

151926

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to furnish one hundred two (102) 50 foot lengths of 3" textile hose, forty two (42) 50 foot lengths of 2½" textile hose, and thirty six 50 foot lengths of 1½" textile hose for the Bureau of Fire, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Fire requires replacement of fire hose which has deteriorated due to frequent, heavy use.
2. The Bureau of Fire has budgeted \$46,788 in its FY 81-82 budget for the purchase of fire hose.
3. A call for bids to furnish fire hose according to specifications submitted to the Purchasing Agent has been recommended by the Chief of the Bureau of Fire and approved by the Commissioner in Charge.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using the specifications filed in his office and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall re-advertise on the same specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a warrant chargeable to the FY 81-82 Budget, General Fund, Bureau of Fire (AU 124), Logistics Division (RU 124), Object Code 320, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in calling for bids will almost certainly result in an eventual higher cost for the hose' therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
