### ORDINANCE NO.

An ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to sign a Purchase Order as a contract with Environmental Pollution Control Inc., P.O. Box 169, Clackamas, Oregon for ten (10) towed sanders for the Bureau of Fleet Management at an estimated cost of \$75,000 without advertising for bids; authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants; waiving performance bond requirements, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Fleet Management requires the timely purchase of 10 additional sanders to be towed by present dump trucks for use by the Maintenance Bureau.
- 2. This purchase is the final of three phases to acquire a total of 32 such sanders as part of the City Snow and Ice Plan.
- 3. In acquiring the prior sanders, the City went to competitive bidding and found that only the Epoke TK12G was acceptable for use by the City. The City subsequently purchased this model for phase two of the Snow and Ice Plan. The other City equipment to be used in conjunction with these sanders have been wired and adapted to provide the greatest interchangeability of units for the most efficient use during an ice or snow emergency.
- 4. The purchase and use of any other unit to complete the program would decrease the interchangeability of the units and therefore the efficiency of the overall program.
- 5. The Bureau of Fleet Management, the Bureau of Maintenance and the Purchasing Agent, therefore, recommend that the City purchase an additional 10 Epoke TK12G sanders without going to competitive bid. As these units are available locally only from Environmental Pollution Control, P.O. Box 169, Clackamas, Oregon, it is also recommended that these units be obtained from this sole source at a final price to be negotiated by the Purchasing Division.
- 6. Funds for this purchase are included in the current 1981-82 City Budget, at a budgeted amount of \$66,000. An adjustment to this budgeted transfer is anticipated and will be presented when the final price is known. Current estimated cost is \$75,000 for the 10 units.

### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent is authorized to negotiate a final price and sign a Purchase Order to serve as a contract with Environmental Pollution Control Inc., P.O. Box 169, Clackamas, Oregon, 97015 for the purchase of 10 Epoke TK12G sanders, for the total estimated cost of \$75,000, without advertising for bids and waiving performance bond requirements.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1981-82 budget: Fleet Operating Fund, Bureau of Fleet Management, 56200037/643 when demand is presented, approval by the proper authorities.

# ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in that delays in acquiring this equipment may result in increased costs to the City and may hamper the ability of the Maintenance Bureau to respond to snow and ice emergencies; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
