

An Ordinance approving an emergency purchase for partial installation of conduit between the Justice Center building and the Portland Building for an estimated amount of \$5,663 for the Bureau of Electronic Services, authorized by the Commissioner of Public Works pursuant to Section 5.32.030 of the Code, Emergency Purchases, authorizing a contract with Standard Utility Contractors, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. A conduit is required between the Justice Center building and the Portland Building to support the City's communication requirements;
2. The City Engineer has instructed the Bureau of Electronic Services to share a trench presently under construction for Pacific Northwest Bell;
3. The Commissioner of Public Works directed the Purchasing Agent to issue an emergency purchase order to accomplish the construction;
4. The Purchasing Agent identified the contractor selected by Pacific Northwest Bell and issued Emergency Purchase Order No. 2736 to Standard Utility Contractors;
5. The action taken by the Commissioner of Public Works should be approved by Ordinance pursuant to Section 5.32.030 of the City Code.
6. This project, and the necessary funds, were approved in the 1981-82 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The installation of the conduit for an estimated amount of \$5,663 as authorized by the Commissioner of Public Works is hereby approved.
- b. The number of this approving Ordinance shall be recorded upon the records of the emergency transaction on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent.
- c. The Purchasing Agent is authorized to enter into a contract with Standard Utility Contractors.

- d. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1981-82 f.y. budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the work will endanger the public welfare; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
