Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The City of Portland, through the Portland Housing Bureau (PHB), has an existing intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with Multnomah County for the Joint Office of Homeless Services (JOHS). The City intends to amend the IGA to extend the term and make other changes as set forth in this thirteenth amendment. Exhibit A includes the complete amendment.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Execution of this thirteenth amendment will not result in any changes to the FY 2022-23 budget for the JOHS, nor does it result in any longer-term financial obligations or benefits.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This Council item authorizes an amendment to an existing IGA between the City and the Multnomah County Department JOHS. The authorization of an amendment to the IGA is a largely internal activity to city government processes. The changes made through this amendment are intended to increase accountability and oversight for the JOHS, which has been expressed as a goal through community engagement.
