

 Build platforms in locations that will improve safe access to pumps and shaft protection cages






 Eliminate continual need to use steep ships stairs






Existing Platform Layout:

- Meet OSHA requirements for fall protection




 Relocate light fixtures that are currently difficult and unsafe to access
