ORDINANCE No. 152876

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to reline the 30-Inch Clay Street River Crossing pipeline for the Bureau of Water Works, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Water Works requires the relining of the 30-Inch Clay Street River Crossing pipeline to ensure a continuing supply of water to the west side of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using plans and specifications filed in his office on FEB 19 1982 and, in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall readvertise on the same basic plans and specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder as designated by Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1981-82 Budget, Water Fund, Project No. 1429 (Clay Street River Crossing), BUC 18600374, Object Code 630 (Improvements), when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase may result in additional expense and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
