ORDINANCE NO. 152034

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids for constructing "Eight Mandicapped Access" projects, authorizing a contract with the lowest responsible bidder, authorizing drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Parks has been given general fund and HCD monies in FY 1986-81 to evaluate, design and construct improvements at Buckman Fieldhouse, Hoyt Arboretum, Laurelhurst Park, Peninsula Community Center, Pittock Mansion, Washington Rose Garden comfort stations, Waterfront Park and Willagette Park to render them accessible to the disables.
- 2. The Park Bureau has received funds through Ordinance 152094 for six of the eight projects and funds will be provided for the other two projects, Peninsula Center and Buckman Fieldhouse, once the supplemental budget is processed.
- 3. The Park Bureau will require the services of a general contractor to implement the planned rehabilitation.
- 4. Plans and specifications have been prepared for the "Project" by John Kyle, Architect, and have been submitted to the Purchasing Agent.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using the specifications filed in his office and in the event no satisfactory bid is received, he shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. The Auditor and the Commissioner-in-Charge are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to BUC 13910421.630 when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the construction projects will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of the completed project; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
